

# Great British Insulation Scheme (GBIS) and ECO4 Flex Declaration Notification Data Dictionary

### Version 1.2

#### Introduction

This document provides information to help to Local Authorities (LAs) and Devolved Administrations (DAs) complete the <u>Great British Insulation Scheme</u> (GBIS) and ECO4 Flex Declaration Notification Template for Flex Declaration Notifications.

A Declaration Notification must be submitted to Ofgem by LAs who wish to refer eligible consumers under ECO4 and GBIS Flex. For more information on Declaration Notifications, see the <u>ECO4 and GBIS Flex Local Authority Guidance</u>.

The Declaration Notification template has been combined for GBIS and ECO4 Flex. LAs do not need to indicate on the template which of the two schemes they are referring households for.

## **Data Types**

The table below sets out each of the fields to be completed in the GBIS and ECO4 Flex Declaration Notification template, and the type of information they require. This includes:

• **Core Data** that must be provided for a Declaration Notification to be notified correctly. If core data is omitted, the declaration notification will be returned for remediation.

• Where Applicable Data that must be provided this where it is applicable (for example, where a particular referral route is being used).

## **Formatting**

Our system cannot accept data unless it is notified in the accepted format. Where core data is not provided in the accepted format, the declaration notification will be returned for remediation.

When submitting a declaration notification, please ensure that:

- only the preset <u>Declaration Notification Template</u> is used (alternative templates and formats will not be accepted)
- all field headings featured in the template (i.e. cells A1 O1) are present
- all text is in the correct case (e.g. CAPITALISED)
- the file is submitted in a .csv file
