Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the electricity interconnector licence held by National Grid Viking Link Limited by adding new special conditions

- 1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the **Authority**)¹ proposes to modify the electricity interconnector licence held by National Grid Viking Link Limited (**NGVL**) granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(e) of the Electricity Act 1989 by inserting into that licence 11 proposed new special conditions, as specified in Schedule 1A of this notice.
- 2. We are proposing these modifications in order to give effect to our September 2020 decision² on the Final Project Assessment of the Viking Link interconnector (the **Viking Link FPA**).
- 3. The effect of the proposed modifications is to implement NGVL's cap and floor regime and reflect the NGVL-specific elements of the cap and floor regime that are contained in the Viking Link FPA decision.
- 4. Specific details on the reasons for, and effects of, the proposed modifications can be found in Schedule 1B of this notice.
- 5. Further details and background on these proposed licence modifications are set out in the Viking Link FPA.
- 6. A copy of the proposed modifications and other documents referred to in this notice are available on the Ofgem website (www.ofgem.gov.uk). Alternatively, they are available from foi@ofgem.gov.uk.
