## Electricity Act 1989 Section 11A(2)

## Notice of statutory consultation on proposal to modify special conditions of the electricity transmission licence held by each of the above licensees

- The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority')<sup>1</sup> proposes to modify the electricity transmission licence held by each of the above licensees ("the licensees") granted or treated as granted under 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989 in the following ways:
  - a. modifying existing Special Condition 1.1 ('SpC 1.1') Interpretation and definitions;
  - b. modifying existing Special Condition 9.14 ('SpC 9.14') Restriction on the use of certain information for Scottish Power Transmission Plc and Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission Plc only;
  - c. inserting the following new special conditions:
    - i. Special Condition 9.20 ('SpC 9.20') Tender Support Activities in Onshore Electricity Transmission
    - ii. Special Condition 9.21 ('SpC 9.21') Conflict Mitigation Arrangements for Onshore Electricity Transmission Tender Exercise
- 2. We are proposing these modifications to give effect to our decision,<sup>2</sup> published on 25 July 2024, in which we explained the role of the incumbent Transmission Owners (TO) within Early Competition and the conflict mitigation arrangements necessary, and in preparation for the proposed Electricity (Early-Model Competitive Tenders for Onshore Transmission Licences) Regulations 2024, if made by the Authority and approved by the Secretary of State.
- The reasons and effects of the proposed modifications, together with the full text of the proposed modifications, are published alongside this notice on our website (<u>www.ofgem.gov.uk</u>), alternatively they are available from <u>Information.Rights@ofgem.gov.uk</u>.
- In addition, further details and background on these proposed changes are set out in our Decision on policy updates to Early Competition in onshore electricity transmission networks<sup>3</sup>.
