Great Britain Fuel Mix Disclosure 2025- Renewable Energy Guarantees of Origin (REGOs)

We are contacting you, as a generator accredited under the Renewable Energy Guarantees of Origin (REGO) scheme, to make you aware of the Great Britain Fuel Mix Disclosure (FMD) deadline for licensed electricity suppliers of 1 July every year. It is likely that your current electricity supplier is endeavouring to comply with the GB FMD deadline and may require you to transfer your REGOs to them to ensure that it is met.

If you are not required or do not intend to sell your REGOs to your supplier, then please ignore the information listed below and no further action is required.

What is Fuel Mix Disclosure?

The Electricity (Fuel Mix Disclosure) Regulations 2005 (SI 2005 No. 391) introduced a requirement on all electricity suppliers in Great Britain to disclose to their customers, and potential customers, the mix of fuels used to generate the electricity supplied annually. REGOs are the main evidence source used by licensed electricity suppliers to prove the proportion of renewable electricity supplied to their customers. As such, if you sell the renewable electricity you generated for the generation period of **1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025** to your supplier, they may also require you to transfer your REGOs for this generation period to them well in advance of their deadline of midday **1 July 2025**.

Claiming and Transferring REGOs

If you are still to submit data to receive and transfer REGOs for generation between **1 April 2024** and **31 March 2025**, please do so as soon as possible. All claims and transfers of REGOs should be made via your account on the Renewables and CHP Register.

Please note, requests made near to the supplier's deadline of **1 July 2025** cannot be guaranteed to be issued and transferred on time to the supplier's account on the Renewables and CHP Register. If you intend to transfer your REGO certificates then please ensure that

your data has been submitted, claimed and transferred to your desired Offtaker/Supplier by **18 June 2025**.

If you experience problems when requesting or transferring your REGOs please contact the RE Compliance Team, in the first instance using the contact details provided at the head of this letter.
