Assurances re SLC 17 of the Gas Suppliers Licences of various RWE Innogy subsidiaries

Following our previous discussions and meetings with you on this issue, in particular your letter of 16 March 2004, I write to re-affirm our commitment to addressing the issues identified in respect of SLC 17 as soon as possible.

In particular, I confirm that each of the relevant licence holders in the RWE Innogy group¹ will by 30 September 2004:

- 1. Undertake a comprehensive review of all meters that as at 1 March 2004 had not been inspected for a period of over two years, and remain unread²;
- 2. As regards the meters referred to in paragraph 1 above, use all reasonable endeavours to:
 - (a) seek access to inspect the meter, including, where necessary, seeking a warrant to gain access to the premises, provided however that a warrant shall only be sought where it is practical to do so and where the relevant sensitivities can be accommodated; or
 - (b) identify and fully explain in each case to Ofgem where there are any genuine and specific exceptions.

I confirm that we will provide a final report on each of the above assurances by 31 October 2004.
