Modification Proposal SSEP012: 'Formally include the Network Code modification rules within the Network Code'.

Ofgem¹ has considered the issues arising from modification proposal SSEP012: 'Formally include the Network Code modification rules within the Network Code' and has decided to direct SSE Pipelines Ltd (SSEP) to implement the modification, as we believe that it will better facilitate the achievement of the relevant objectives of SSEP's Network Code, as set out in Standard Condition 9 of its GT licence. Ofgem also considers that this decision is consistent with its wider statutory duties. In this letter we explain the background to the modification proposal and outline the reasons for making our decision.

Background to the proposal

The GT licence requires SSEP to establish transportation arrangements consistent with its duties under section 9 of the Act and to facilitate the achievement of the relevant objectives. These arrangements are to be in a document referred to as the Network Code. The licensee is similarly required to prepare a document setting out the modification procedures for the Network Code.

Currently, the SSEP modification rules form a separate document to the Network Code itself. This has implications insofar as the modifications rules are not subject to the governance that they themselves provide, though they may only be changed with the consent of the Authority.

The Modification Proposal

Modification proposal SSEP012 seeks to include the Network Code modification rules formally into the Network Code itself. In effect this would mean that the modification rules would constitute part of the Network Code and therefore be subject to the same change control procedures, allowing parties to the Network Code to propose changes to the rules.

Respondent's views

SSEP received only one representation to its consultation on modification proposal SSEP012. The respondent supported its implementation, commenting that they support the principle of aligning iGT Network Codes with those of NGT (which now incorporates by reference, the Uniform Network Code).

SSEP's View

SSEP supports the implementation of this modification proposal, stating that it will allow shippers the ability to propose changes to the modifications rules and provide a common approach to governance across the gas and electricity markets.

Ofgem's View

Ofgem welcomes the principle of more open access to the governance of gas and electricity industry codes by contracted parties. Open and transparent processes underpin effective and efficient consultation and consideration of modification proposals.

Ofgem notes and agrees with SSEP's comment that this modification should lead to a common approach to governance across the gas and electricity markets, though this is not in itself justification for change, nor a Network Code relevant objective. However, the alignment of certain industry processes can be expected to lead to efficiency gains for all parties and generally facilitate competition, through increased transparency and shipper confidence in the market arrangements.

Ofgem's decision


Having considered the issues arising from this modification proposal Ofgem has decided to direct SSEP to implement modification proposal SSEP012, as it will contribute to the efficient and economic operation of the pipe-line system by improving the existing governance procedures. To the extent that improved governance can increase transparency and parties' confidence in the market framework, it should also further facilitate the securing of effective competition between gas shippers and suppliers.

Ofgem notes that the legal text provided as part of the Final Modification Report contained a few obsolete references, which may be indicative of SSEP Network Code as a whole. Ofgem also consents to the modification of the SSEP Network Code, in accordance with standard condition 9(7)(b) of SSEP's Gas Transporter Licence, as follows:

- All references to "Director General of Gas Supply", or "**Director**", shall be replaced by the "Gas and Electricity Markets Authority", or "**Authority**" as appropriate;
- All references to "**Ofgas**" shall be replaced by "**Ofgem**".
