**Modification Proposal UGI14: Section O, Information and Confidentiality.**

Ofgem have considered the issues raised in this modification proposal and have decided to direct Utility Grid Installations Ltd (UGI) to implement the proposal as we believe that it will better facilitate the relevant objectives of UGIs GT Licence.

**The Modification Proposal**

This modification proposal seeks to amend an incorrect reference in Section O of the UGI Network Code. Paragraph 1.3.4 currently refers to the 'Data Protection Act 1984', but should refer to the 'Data Protection Act 1998'.

**Respondents Views**

UGI received two responses in relation to this modification proposal, both of which were supportive.

**Ofgem's Views**


Ofgem supports the implementation of this proposal as it will ensure that the Network Code contains up to date references.

**Ofgem's decision**

Having considered the issues raised by this modification proposal Ofgem has decided to direct UGI to implement modification proposal 14, as it will contribute to the efficient and economic operation of the pipe-line system and to the fulfilment of the relevant code objectives, particularly Standard Condition 9.1 (a).

In accordance with condition 9 (9) (b) of the standard conditions of Utility Grid Installations Ltd Gas Transporters Licence, dated 22 January 2001, Utility Grid Installations Ltd is directed to make the above proposal (as contained in Utility Grid Installations Ltd Network Code Modification report 14 dated 29 April 2005) as a modification to the Network Code.
